He was a coach, teacher, athletic director, referee, and leader in the Bergen County high school sports scene for over 70 years. This scholarship will recognize one male and one female student athlete who embodies the very characteristics by which Mickey lived his life.

Those characteristics would include showing respect to teammates, opponents, officials and coaches. The applicant should be of high moral character and should be extremely coachable. Mickey felt that the greatest classrooms for a student athlete are the courts and fields of athletic competition. It is through athletic competition that the participant is taught lessons not found in the classroom but which are essential in achieving academic success.

Mickey was an extreme giver and therefore we wanted these scholarships to be generous. The amount of this scholarship will be \$2,500.00 to one male and one female student athlete who meet our criteria. The application provided includes the criteria.

The essay should be no more than 400 words. The student's name and high school name should be typed on the back of the essay. Staple the essay to the back of the application and ask your Athletic Director to certify that you meet the criteria (see above below). The Athletic Director or you may submit the application to the Guidance Department no later than 3/13/18, unless directed otherwise by Guidance.
