The Armenian Relief Society of Bergen County is pleased to announce the continuance of its scholarship program. Scholarships in the amount of \$750.00 will be awarded for the 2018-2019 academic year, to qualified high school students graduating in June of 2018.

Stipulations are as follows:

1. Scholarships will be awarded to high school students of Armenian heritage (proof is needed) who are residents of the United States and have resided in Bergen County for not less than a year.
2. Scholarship applications are available to high school seniors who are applying to an accredited four-year college or university.
3. The primary criterion for awarding scholarships is academic excellence. To qualify, students should have an A-B average.
4. Additional points will be given for Armenian education and membership in Armenian Cultural Organizations, as well as involvement in the Armenian and local community and school athletics or activities.
5. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right not to award scholarships. In the event the said committee, in its sole judgement, determines that all applicants are deemed unqualified.
